SCHEDULING CONFERENCE SET

In its November 2, 2015 response to Daryl Williams' Motion to Withdraw as counsel for [REDACTED], Plaintiff requested that the Court hold a hearing to address Mr. Williams' representation of the [REDACTED] in light of their claim that they had never authorized Mr. Williams to represent them. Plaintiff is concerned about the impact such allegations may have on the Court's October 19, 2015 order granting summary judgment against the [REDACTED].

Because the Court denied Mr. Williams' Motion to Withdraw without prejudice, the Court declines to hold a hearing to address the representation at this time. Rather, the Court will make a determination regarding the need for a hearing after an amended motion to withdraw is filed and the [REDACTED] have had an opportunity to respond.

On October 30, 2015, the parties submitted a Joint Status Report and Request for Rule 16 Conference.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall file a proposed Scheduling Order in WORD format **by December 10, 2015**. If the parties disagree on specific deadlines, each side shall set forth its request separately.

NOTE: All court proceedings are recorded by audio and video method and not by a court reporter. Pursuant to Local Rule 2.22, if a party desires a court reporter for any proceeding in which a court reporter is not mandated by Arizona Supreme Court Rule 30, the party must submit a written request to the assigned judicial officer at least ten (10) judicial days in advance of the hearing, and must pay the authorized fee to the Clerk of the Court at least two (2) judicial days before the proceeding. The fee is \$140 for a half-day and \$280 for a full day.
